GEONAV on board the "STELLA POLARE" & "CAPRICIA"

After years of collaboration with the ship "**Palinuro**", GEONAV is proud to announce that it has become the official supplier to the Italian Navy's other two training vessels: "**Stella Polare**" & "**Capricia**".

In the spirit of continuous evolution and the desire to improve our products, together with the goal to please all those who live and breathe the spirit of the sea, it is for this reason that GEONAV has strengthened its relations with the Italian Navy.

"**Stella Polare**", was commissioned in 1964 and launched in September 1965. It was built as a training vessel for the cadets of the Italian Naval Academy at Livorno. It soon revealed itself to be an excellent racer, winning many trophies and participating in several editions of the Cutty Sark Regatta.

Built completely with cedar oak from Lebanon, "**Capricia**" was born in Sweden, starting off as a racing vessel in 1963 and obtaining many victories in regattas, such New York Yacht Club Trophy Race and the Britannia Cup. In 1993 it was donated to the Italian Navy by the "Fondazione Agnelli" and since then has seen service as a training vessel for the cadets, sailing mainly in the Mediterranean.

Amongst other instruments present, we would like to point out the GEONAV 6 Sunshine colour plotter, with its highly visible screen, the brand new **NAVIONICS GOLD XL3** cartography permits navigation in practically the whole Mediterranean with only one cartridge and our range of binoculars for marine use the **GEONAV SEARANGER III** and **GEONAV SEAKING II**.
